Dear Biblical Student:

We are happy to learn of your interest in the Catholic Biblical School. Ours is a special kind of program requiring a special kind of commitment. Therefore we ask each applicant to attend an information meeting before making a final decision about joining with us in our exploration of scripture and faith.

There are two main reasons for the information meeting: (1) to give you the information you need to make an informed choice about enrolling in the Catholic Biblical School, and (2) to provide an opportunity for you to ask questions. We also want to meet you and learn of any special needs or interests you may have.

You can make an appointment for the information meeting by contacting BJ Daly Horell by email (bjdalyhorell@adh-ore.org) or by telephone (860-243-9465, extension 11). We will schedule meetings through August 15, 2009 at the Archdiocesan Office of Religious Education, 467 Bloomfield Avenue, Bloomfield, CT 06002-2999. Since we accept students on a first-come, first-served basis, you would be wise to make an appointment as early as possible in the process.

At the information meeting, you will need *your completed application form*. If, during the meeting, we discern that the Catholic Biblical School is a good choice for you, you can at that time reserve your place in next year's class by submitting *half* of your 2009-2010 tuition. The remaining tuition is due by October 1, 2009, unless we make other arrangements.

Tuition for the entire year (30 weeks) is \$250; a tuition deposit of \$125 reserves your place. In addition, you will also need to purchase textbooks, which will be available at your information meeting. (The cost of textbooks is *not* included in CBS tuition.)

The registration process must be *completed* by August 15, 2009. A required Orientation Day will be held on September 12, 2009, from 9:00-3:00 at St. Thomas Seminary, and classes begin the week of September 14, 2009.

We are happy you want to join our study of God's Word, a truly life-giving process.
