Tricia Hoyt is the director of the Office of Parish and Community Engagement at Catholic Charities in the Diocese of Phoenix, Arizona, where her work is to encourage parishes to take on the full perspective of Parish Social Ministry as a component of its Catholic identity. She holds a M.A. in Adult Christian Community Development from Regis University (Denver) and is currently a PhD student in Biblical Interpretation at Brite Divinity School (Fort Worth). She is a leader and instructor on the Phoenix-based *Survival School: Church Leadership Training*, a national lay leadership training event. Tricia is co-author of the *MOMS - Ministry of Mothers Sharing* books, published by Resource Publications, and a Spanish-language version of the ministry, *De Madre a Madre*.



She teaches nationally on sacred and biblical storytelling, spirituality and ministry and has offered workshops in Reno, Cincinnati, Seattle, Denver and Albuquerque as well as in Limerick and Ennis, Ireland. She is a frequent Coordinator and Lay Presider at the Los Angeles Religious Education Congress.
